One or two of these ideas you may have come across before, I've tried to only include those that don't require any or little experience and can be done from home especially during the current global pandemic.

Now I've not tried every one of these but just a couple, you can quickly scan through these and just cherry pick the ones that appeal to you and give those a try.

Most of these don't require any upfront cost while one or two may require a little upfront money to get started with.

1. Surveys:

Completing paid surveys online is an easy way to make money online, that pay in various ways from gift cards, real cash and other perks. If you decide to try this option, I advise you to create or use an email just for doing these surveys.

You're not going to get rich taking surveys, but you can earn some extra money that could help you.

I've done my best to try and find legit survey sites there are some dodgy ones out there, so it's always best to do your own due diligence first before joining any survey sites, but this should be enough to get you started with.

2. Tasks:

Do Tasks such as odd jobs for people via task outsourcing websites, simple jobs like assembling a table or desk, cleaning the bathroom or Kitchen and even planting flowers. And a host of other jobs.

3. Sell Your Photos:

Did you know you can sell your photos even if you are not an expert photographer? Now a days you can just use a mobile with a decent camera such as an iPhone to take the pictures with. If you love taking photos, then why not also make money from doing what you love?

4. Test & Review Websites for Cash:

Give feedback on products you love and use, as long as you have a PC or Mac or smart device. You can get paid for testing websites, apps, watching videos and more. You follow a task or set of instructions and then speak out loud your thoughts, what you like or disliked etc.

5. Get Paid for shopping online:

You may be wondering how do you get paid for shopping online? Sites that are called cash back sites receive a commission for referring online shoppers to merchants. When you buy something through these sites from a merchant that partners with these cashback sites, the sites pass on some of the commission to you.

That free money is then known as cashback. There are literally thousands of these online merchants you can earn cashback from, such as Amazon, Bingo sites, travel booking sites and much more.

I've used TopCashBack and you do get paid but you can wait up to a few months before your money clears, they pay either through PayPal or straight into your bank account. 6. No-Risk Match Betting:

In the UK this is probably the quickest method I've found for myself to make money legally online. This works by taking advantage of the free bets that are offered by betting sites and this is something that I've successfully used for the past 4 months.

I was doing this for 4 months and still do when I've the time, in the first week I earned £196.37 or about \$265.54 tax free!

Now if you're not in the UK you'll need to check if you would have the same benefits. I know in the UK you don't pay any taxes as it's considered gambling, although I can assure you its definitely not.

7. Get Paid for searching on the web:

Get paid for doing what you would normally do if you have a computer then why not try the below sites just sign up and start searching.

- <u>Swagabucks</u> offer two ways to search, both of which are powered by Yahoo.
- <u>Bing Rewards</u> A Microsoft search engine Google's competitor, if the link doesn't work got to bing.com then type Bing rewards in search box, and signup.
- Qmee.com rewards you for searching Google, Yahoo, Bing, Amazon and eBay.

8. Review Music

Listen to music and write your thoughts about the music you've just listened to and make money, it's that simple.

These websites pay people to review music of new and upcoming singers and song writers which in turn helps the musical artists find direction they require for their songs.

- <u>Slicethepie</u> Launched in 2007 a site used to identify the best and upcoming artists
- Musicxray a platform for singers and song writers who submit their songs which
 then you can listen to and earn money from. You get paid through PayPal –
 Important when you sign up choose the option "Music Fan", you'll then be asked to
 sync your Facebook account which you must do in order for your fan account to work
 properly.
- <u>Current.US</u> An Android and IOS mobile app that pays around \$600 a year, just for playing music on your mobile
- <u>Radioearn</u> This is a great website if you want to earn money by listening to the radio, simply signup it's 100% free, after registering sign in and click open on your radio links, every 15 minutes you get points that are converted the following month to USD which is paid out either via bank transfer (wire), Amazon gift cards or Bitcoin (BTC).

9. Sell Books

Sell second-hand textbooks:

At end of the year, purchase other students' textbooks and sell them when the students enroll the following year on Amazon or eBay. You don't need to be a student to take advantage of buying and selling textbooks.

A good way to do this is either buy from <u>BookScouter</u> and list them on eBay or the other way around, always check on eBay the sold for prices in completed listings to have an idea of what the book might go for.

A focus group is a small group of people that have been invited to share their opinions either in person or online. An online focus group is similar to an offline one, you join an online chat using your mobile device which you receive a link to through an email.

Which allows you to join the focus group and give your feedback. Some use video or specific web-based software to do this. Each focus group is different, and you can expect to earn between \$30-\$150 per focus group, but this can vary.

The amount of time to complete these is around 1-2 hours, payment is usually via PayPal, check or gift card.

Make sure to check how you get paid before doing these.

17. Transcription:

Transcription jobs especially for working from home are extremely popular, transcribing involves listening to audio files and then converting them to text, have the advantage of being able to be done from almost anywhere and at any time.

The three main areas are medical, legal and general. Most starting out don't tend to have specific experience in the first two so opt for the general area. Although you need to be punctual and proficient in spelling as well as accurate.

But nowadays this isn't so much of an issue as you have tools such as word processors and grammar checking tools.

One other thing you'll need is to be accustomed to repetition as you'll need to replay the audio a few times until you can perfectly capture all of the words
